

**MINUTES**  
**COUNCIL MEETING**  
**SEPTEMBER 20, 2007**  
**7:00 p.m.**

In compliance with N.J.S.A. 10:4, Open Public Meetings Law, notice was given to two newspapers and posted, that a council meeting of the Mayor and Council was scheduled for Thursday, September 20, 2007 at 7:00 P.M. The Municipal Clerk took the roll call and showed that all were present with the exception of Councilman D'Amico, Councilman Whalen and Councilwoman Martz. The Engineer Mr. Basehore was present and also Police Chief Doyle.

A motion was made by Councilman DePrince to open this portion of the meeting to the public. Councilwoman Bonamassa seconded. All Council voting aye.

No one from the public spoke.

Motion made by Councilman Wilson to close the meeting to the public, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa, with all Council voting aye.

Old Business:

There was no old business.

New Business:

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to adopt Resolution 2007:145 Cancellation of Tax Title Lien Account Redemption Amounts recommended by the CFO. All Council voted aye.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to adopt Resolution 2007:146 Authorizing the Mayor and Clerk to execute the County Interlocal Agreement for Salt and Snow Removal on County Roads. All Council voted aye.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilman Wilson to adopt Resolution 2007:147 to designate an alternate Councilperson for the Planning Board in Councilman D'Amico's absence. Councilwoman Martz was named with all Council voting aye.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to adopt Resolution 2007:148 for a Maintenance Lien for B. 3.04, L. 24, 208 South Cumberland Avenue in the amount of \$150. All Council voted aye.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilman Wilson to adopt Resolution 2007:149 to lift the No Parking on NW Atlantic Avenue for the flea market. All Council voted aye.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to approve the minutes for the September 05, 2007 meeting. All Council voted aye.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to approve the bill list as submitted by the Treasurer Robin Sarlo. All Council voted aye by roll call.

Motion made by Councilwoman Bonamassa, seconded by Councilman DePrince to go in to Closed Session (Resolution 2007:144). All Council voted aye.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilman Wilson to come out of Closed Session. All Council voted aye.

Roundtable:

Councilman Wilson had some questions on cutting grass on vacant properties. He also reported the trash truck was fixed and was costly.

The Engineer Mr. Basehore reported the DEP plans and specs was accepted for the NJEIT project. The final docs for Gloucester Avenue were being prepared. There are some new cell antennae to add to the existing tower.

The Solicitor had nothing to report.

Councilwoman Bonamassa reported the Halloween Parade this year would start at Borough Hall and end at the Community Center.
