

MINUTES
COUNCIL MEETING
MARCH 04, 2009
7:00 p.m.

In compliance with N.J.S.A. 10:4, Open Public Meetings Law, notice was given to two newspapers and posted, that a council meeting of the Mayor and Council was scheduled for Wednesday, March 04, 2009 at 7:00 P.M. The Municipal Clerk took the roll call and showed that all were present. The Engineer Mr. Bach was also present.

A motion was made by Councilman Whalen to open this portion of the meeting to the public. Councilwoman Martz seconded. All Council voting aye.
Motion made by Councilman Wilson to close the meeting to the public, seconded by Councilwoman Martz, with all Council voting aye.

Motion was made to go into Executive Session after reviewing the Agenda during the 7:00 PM session, (Resolution 2009:49) by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilman DePrince, with all Council voting aye.
Council left the Room to enter into Executive Session.
Motion was made by Councilman Wilson to come out of Executive Session, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa, with all Council voting aye.

The 8:00 Regular Session began.

Motion made by Councilman Wilson, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to open the meeting to the public, all Council voted aye.
Alex Esposito of 407 W. Brooke inquired to the light study of the parking light at the Community Center. He was told the report was available through an OPRA request. He inquired about disturbance of noise at the Community Center and wanted to be informed of the dates and times of events at the Community Center. He was concerned of the impact on the neighborhood. The Solicitor tried to answer his concerns. Mr. Esposito also questioned the reasoning for minutes that were tabled in 2008 and why the meetings were not recorded. The Solicitor explained to Mr. Esposito the he will not allow the Clerk, Mayor and Council to be direct or cross examined.

Mr. Anderson thanked the DPW on the snow removal during the recent snow storm since they did a fine job.

Mr. Esposito thanked Mr. Wilson and Miss Martz for their efforts regarding the PSE&G light at the Community Center.
Motion by Councilman Wilson to close the public session, seconded by Councilman Whalen, with all Council voting aye.

Motion made by Councilman Brandt, seconded by Councilman Wilson to approve Resolution 2009:50 for the Change Order #1 for Charles/Madison Avenues Project to American Asphalt. This was made on recommendation of the Engineer. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilman Brandt to approve Resolution 2009:51 to execute the Shared Service Agreement with Laurel Springs for the Court Services. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilman Wilson to approve Resolution 2009:52 for the refund of a street opening permit by Buividas Builders in the amount of \$1,000, This was inspected and approved by DPW Supervisor Stephen Pacella. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Brandt, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to approve Resolution 2009:53 to execute the 2009 Engineer and Planner Agreements. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Brandt, seconded by Councilman Wilson to approve Resolution 2009:54 to modify the Developers Agreement for the Coopertown Project. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Councilman Whalen read the Treasurer's Report submitted by Robin Sarlo.

Councilman Brandt stated the Rec Committee is getting ready for the Public Events in April with the Egg Hunt, Clean Communities Day, and Opening Day with Little League.

Councilman Wilson stated DPW did a great job with the snow. He read the DPW February monthly report.

Councilwoman Martz read the Code Compliance report, and the Construction Office report. She gave an update on the dog and cat license report and stated late fees began in March.

Councilman DePrince read the Ambulance, Fire and Police reports. He congratulated the line officers recently installed at the Fire Company Dinner.

Councilman Whalen stated we are still operating under a temporary budget. He spoke of the capital items for 2009.

Councilwoman Bonamassa read the IT report from Nick D'Amico and informed us she had attended a Safety Committee Report.

The Engineer stated he submitted his report in writing to everyone. He gave an update on the Charles/Madison Avenues project. He stated they were reviewing the possibility of not replacing some of the pipe sections on Brooke Avenue due to the pipe being in good condition.

Motion made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman DePrince to open the meeting to the public. All Council voted aye.

Mr. Esposito asked for dates of the light report and the Brooke Avenue report. The Engineer responded. He also wanted to know about the computer server issue.

Peg Millisky inquired to the pipe section not being replaced on Brooke Avenue. The Engineer answered her question.

Mrs. Stewart of Barrington inquired to the large basin at the Commons Project. The Solicitor stated he had no comment on that Project due to litigation.

Mr. Anderson had questions of the modification of the Cooperstowne Project. The Solicitor responded, but Mr. Anderson stated he had different information and would provide it to the Solicitor.

Mr. Esposito inquired to the FedEx basin and if equipment was ready with boat rescue. Councilman DePrince stated there was a mutual aid agreement for that type of equipment.

Motion made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman Brandt to close the public session. All Council voted aye.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilman Wilson to approve the bills to be paid. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Brandt, seconded by Councilman Wilson to adjourn the meeting. All Council voted aye.



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
