

MINUTES
COUNCIL MEETING
OCTOBER 18, 2007
7:00 p.m.

In compliance with N.J.S.A. 10:4, Open Public Meetings Law, notice was given to two newspapers and posted, that a council meeting of the Mayor and Council was scheduled for Thursday, October 18, 2007 at 7:00 P.M. The Municipal Clerk took the roll call and showed that all were present with the exception of Councilman D'Amico who arrived late at 7:45 PM, and Councilman DePrince. The Engineer Mr. Basehore was present and also Police Chief Doyle.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Martz to open this portion of the meeting to the public. Councilwoman Bonamassa seconded. All Council voting aye.

No one from the public spoke.

Motion made by Councilman Wilson to close the meeting to the public, seconded by Councilwoman Martz, with all Council voting aye.

Old Business:

There was no old business.

New Business:

Motion made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman Wilson to adopt Resolution 2007:154 Place to Place Transfer of ABC License #0423-32-001-007 Columbo. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to approve the minutes for the September 20, 2007 meeting, with all Council voting aye.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to approve the payment of bills as submitted by the Treasurer Robin Sarlo. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Round Table Discussion:

Councilman Wilson stated he would like to appoint Jason Cairns as Seasonal Temporary Help. He had worked this past summer and was a good worker with no issues. Motion made by Councilman Wilson, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to appoint Jason Cairns as Seasonal Temporary Help at the same rate as he was paid for summer work. (Resolution 2007:155) All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Councilman Wilson also stated the DPW was reviewing possibly picking up trash for Woodlynne Borough.

The Engineer Mr. Basehore explained there were leftover CDBG funds to use to reimburse the Borough for funds for the Monroe Avenue Project. Council agreed to have the leftover funds reimburse the Borough for funds expended on the Monroe Project.

Councilwoman Martz stated the attorney Mr. Manieri for St. Gregory's Church had spoken to the Construction Official. The Church was taking no action at this time. The Solicitor stated he will be working on wording a summons to the Church.

Councilwoman Martz also stated Mr. Lattany resigned from his Planning Board position. The Mayor was looking at replacements.

Councilman Whalen stated he had spoken to the Auditor Todd Saler to be present at the November 07, 2007 meeting to further discuss options for the sewer utility for repayment of the NJ DEP Trust.

Councilwoman Bonamassa explained the dates for upcoming public events. The next event is the Grand Opening of the Community Center on October 27, and following this event is the Halloween Parade on October 30.

The Solicitor stated he had a form available to file with Rutgers to hopefully get a student intern to work at the Borough Hall.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to adjourn the meeting. All Council voted aye.
