

MINUTES
COUNCIL MEETING
DECEMBER 03, 2008

7:00 p.m.

In compliance with N.J.S.A. 10:4, Open Public Meetings Law, notice was given to two newspapers and posted, that a council meeting of the Mayor and Council was scheduled for Wednesday, December 03, 2008 at 7:00 P.M. The Municipal Clerk took the roll call and showed that all were present with the exception of Councilman DePrince. The Engineer Mr. Basehore was present.

At 7:00 PM the Council reviewed the agenda for 8:00 PM.

Motion made by Councilman N. D'Amico, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to adopt Resolution 2008:175 to enter into Closed Session, with all Council voting aye.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa with all Council voting aye.

The 8:00 PM Council session began.

The Mayor asked for a moment of silence for Councilman DePrince's mother and Public Works Superintendent Steve Pacella's mother who both had passed away recently.

Motion made by Councilman Wilson, seconded by Councilman D'Amico to open the meeting to the Public. All voted in favor.

No public spoke.

Motion by Councilman Wilson, seconded by Councilman Whalen to close the meeting to the Public. All Council voted aye.

Motion made by Councilman Wilson, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to adopt Resolution 2008:174 to authorize the execution of the Laurel Springs Interlocal Agreement for trash and recyclable pick up for 2009, 2010, and 2011. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Wilson, seconded by Councilman D'Amico to adopt Ordinance 2008:16 for first reading to amend and include the towing fees of \$85.00 to tow and \$25.00 per day for storage. All Council agreed.

Motion made by Councilwoman Bonamassa, seconded by Councilman Whalen to approve the minutes of November 20, 2008. All Council voted aye with the exception of Councilman D'Amico who was not present at that meeting.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to approve the bill list as submitted. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilwoman Bonamassa, seconded by Councilman Wilson to approve Resolution 2008:176 to execute the Camden County Co-op Agreement for the purchase of Sodium Chloride. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman D'Amico, seconded by Councilman Wilson to approve Resolution 2008:177 to approve the Chapter 159 for the Body Armor Grant in the amount of \$1,079.48. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilman Martz to approve Resolution 2008:178 to approve the Chapter 159 for the NJ DOT Grant in the amount of \$150,000. for Madison Avenue. All voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilman D'Amico to approve Resolution 2008:179 to appoint Class II Special Police Officer Erik Weist. All Council vote aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to approve Resolution 2008:180 to appoint Class II Special Police Officer Andrew Weist. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Roundtable:

Councilman Wilson read the Public Works report for the month of November.

Councilwoman Bonamassa spoke of the busy month ahead for the holiday events. Reorganization meeting will take place on January 07, 2009 at the Borough Hall.

Councilwoman Martz read the report for the Construction Department Office

Councilman DePrince's reports for Police, Court and Fire were submitted in writing.

Councilman D'Amico stated he was working SJTP to resolve some website issues.

Councilman Whalen read the monthly Treasurer Report. He also stated the borough was working on delinquent taxes on businesses in town. They are to be paid prior to the year end. He asked all departments to please watch your spending as the 2008 budget comes to an end.

The Solicitor stated he had nothing to report in open session.

The Engineer stated the NJ DOT Grant would be sufficient to cover the construction of Williams Avenue but not inspection. He stated he has submitted in this month's report the allocation required for funding for future projects.

Motion made by Councilman D'Amico, seconded by Councilman Whalen to open the public session. All Council voted aye. Peg Millisky inquired to where the annual reorganization would be held. Council stated they decided to bring it back to the Borough Hall rather than the Community Center.

Steve Previtore of the Fire Company inquired about the Right to Know forms being filed by the local businesses with their annual renewals.

Motion by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilman D'Amico to adjourn the meeting. All Council voted aye.



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
