

MINUTES
COUNCIL MEETING
FEBRUARY 15, 2007
7:00 p.m.

In compliance with N.J.S.A. 10:4, Open Public Meetings Law, notice was given to two newspapers and posted, that a special council meeting of the Mayor and Council was scheduled for Thursday, February 15, 2007 at 7:00 P.M. The Municipal Clerk took the roll call and showed that all were present. The Engineer Mr. Basehore was present.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Martz to open this portion of the meeting to the public. Councilman DePrince seconded. All Council voting aye. No one was present. Motion made by Councilman Whalen to close the meeting to the public, seconded by Councilwoman Martz, with all Council voting aye.

New Business:

Motion made to approve the minutes of February 07, 2007 was made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilwoman Martz, with all Council voting aye.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen to approve the bill list as submitted by the Treasurer, seconded by Councilwoman Martz with all Council voting aye by roll call vote.

The Engineer explained the two letters they wrote recommending payment to DeMelio for Gloucester and Bryant Avenues. He also explained the NJ Environmental Infrastructure Trust meeting was February 22, 2007 and the application was required to be submitted by March 05, 2007.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilman DePrince for Resol. 2007:48 Closed Session. All Council voted aye.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to come out of Closed Session, with all Council voting aye.

Round Table:

Councilman Wilson spoke about the car battery issue in the code enforcement car. Also he gave status on the snow and ice.

Councilwoman Martz stated Denise O'Kane started in the Construction Office and is doing well. The status of the FedEx final inspections was discussed.

Councilman D'Amico stated he had nothing to report.

Councilman DePrince stated the first year of the Verizon cell phones was coming up, and new phones per the contract would be received soon at no cost. The Ambulance Alliance is moving forward. He discussed the Lincoln Avenue survey which the Clerk and he are working on. This will ask residents how they want the parking to be handled on their street. The AOC new computers are in, and were installed in the Court.

Councilwoman Bonamassa inquired about the floor waxing. The Clerk explained the Sterling HS crew was to do it over the Spring Break.

Councilman Whalen stated he has met with the CFO and the budget for 2007 is very tight. A March 04, 2007 meeting is being planned at 1PM.
