

MINUTES
COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 02, 2010
7:00 p.m.

In compliance with N.J.S.A. 10:4, Open Public Meetings Law, notice was given to two newspapers and posted, that a council meeting of the Mayor and Council was scheduled for Wednesday, June 02, 2010 at 7:00 P.M. The Municipal Clerk took the roll call and showed that all were present. The Engineer Mr. Basehore was present.

Review of the agenda for the 8:00 pm session was completed.

Motion by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman Whalen to adopt Resolution 2010:96 for Closed Session, with all Council voting aye. Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to come out Closed Session with all Council voting aye.

The 8:00 pm session began, and Councilman DePrince was still not present.

Motion was made by Councilman Brandt, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to open the meeting to the public. All Council voted aye.

No one from the public spoke.

Motion was made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman Brandt to close the meeting to the public. All Council voted aye.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to adopt the May 20, 2010 meeting minutes. All Council voted aye with the exception of Councilman Whalen who abstained since he was not present at the May 20, 2010 meeting.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilman Whalen to approve Resolution 2010:97 for Maintenance Liens 203 Gloucester Avenue \$150; 606 Harrison Avenue \$150; 606 Grant Avenue \$150; 340 W. Evesham \$150; 701 Brooke Avenue \$150. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to adopt Resolution 2010:98 to award the road reconstruction bid to American Asphalt for the extended bid which included the alternate bid #1 in the amount of \$43,434.34. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilman DePrince to adopt Resolution 2010:99 in support of the Sterling HS Pepsi Grant to help fund the music program. All Council voted aye.

Councilman Whalen read the monthly Treasurer's Report.

Councilman Wilson stated his report was submitted in writing. He stated the mulch installation at the park was complete around the play equipment. Jay Miles thanked the Stratford Sewer Utility for the repair of the sewer jetter truck.

The Engineer stated Jackson Avenue Pre-Construction Meeting would be scheduled soon, and the Safe Route to Schools Grant documents were being worked on. He stated the Citgo Project was waiting for Planning Board Engineer to approve.

Councilwoman Martz stated she submitted her report in writing. The dog and cat census was not yet done, but should be soon. She commented that there was a new Family Dollar Store coming at the old drug store location at White Horse Pike and Warwick Road.

Councilman Brandt stated the 4th of July events were coming along with over 20 vendors signed up. Summer rec program was moving along.

Councilman DePrince stated his reports were submitted in writing.

Councilman Whalen stated the 2010 budget was introduced and with no municipal tax increase.

Councilwoman Bonamassa stated her report was submitted and Nick D'Amico was working on the installation of the wireless network.
