

MINUTES
COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 03, 2009
7:00 p.m.

In compliance with N.J.S.A. 10:4, Open Public Meetings Law, notice was given to two newspapers and posted, that a council meeting of the Mayor and Council was scheduled for Wednesday, June 03, 2009 at 7:00 P.M. The Municipal Clerk took the roll call and showed that all were present. The Engineer Mr. Basehore was also present.

A motion was made by Councilman Brandt to open this portion of the meeting to the public. Councilwoman Martz seconded. All Council voting aye.

No one from the public spoke.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince to close the meeting to the public, seconded by Councilwoman Martz, with all Council voting aye.

Motion was made to go into Executive Session after reviewing the Agenda during the 7:00 PM session, (Resolution 2009:86) by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilman Wilson, with all Council voting aye.

Council left the Room to enter into Executive Session.

Motion was made by Councilman Wilson to come out of Executive Session, seconded by Councilman DePrince, with all Council voting aye.

The 8:00 Regular Session began.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to open the meeting to the public, all Council voted aye.

No one from the public spoke.

Motion made by Councilwoman Bonamassa, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to close the public portion. All Council voted aye.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince to approve, seconded by Councilman Wilson, for the minutes of the meeting of May 21, 2009, with all Council voting aye.

OLD BUSINESS:

One Day Vending License for Alex's Lemonade Stand was requested by Denise Strehle who was present. She explained this was to raise money for cancer research and also requested a waiver of the license fee. It would take place on June 13, a Saturday afternoon. Motion was made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to approve the license and to waive the fee. All Council voted aye.

A Business License for The Devine Beauty Salon to be located at 104 Otterbranch Avenue, B. 8.01, L. 7 made by resident Mrs. Rosario, who was present. After discussion she requested the closing time be extended to 8 pm to cover the future time when business may be busy enough to warrant. Motion made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman Brandt with all Council voting aye by roll call.

Motion made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman Brandt to adopt Resolution 2009:87 for a Maintenance Lien on B. 1.03, L. 3 for 340 W. Evesham Ave., and for B. 3.11, L. 40 510 S. White Horse Pike. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to adopt Resolution 2009:88 for State Contract T0322 for purchase of Recycling Containers. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilman Brandt to adopt Resolution 2009:89 to appoint SLEO Officer Daniel L. Colombaro. All Council voted aye by roll call vote. He was sworn in by the Mayor.

Motion made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman Brandt to introduce Ordinance 2009:10 Rental Properties. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Brandt, seconded by Councilman Whalen to adopt Resolution 2009:90A, 2009:90B, 2009:90C; 2009:90D, and 2009:90E for the five liquor license renewals for the 2009-2010 year. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to introduce Ordinance 2009:11 to Amend Chapter 115 Construction Costs Section 115-3B 2(a), 1(f) and 2. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilman Brandt to adopt Resolution 2009:91 for State Contract #71048 and 71059 to purchase Fire Gear. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Councilman Whalen read the Treasurer's Report for May 2009.

Round Table:

Councilman Brandt stated Summer Rec sign up was finishing; the parade was being worked on; the park vendors are in line for July 4th; National Night Out is going to take place on the same night as the string band.

Councilman Wilson read the DPW report.

Councilwoman Martz read the Enforcement Code Report, the Construction Report and stated the Planning Board is working on the Master Plan, and she stated that Mr. and Mrs. Comella and two others will be doing the animal census. It will be \$700. split to 4 people, and it will include the apartments.

Councilman DePrince read the Police report and the Court report.

Councilman Whalen spoke of deleting the July night for the front office. He would follow-up with Council. He stated the departments should be reviewing their budget and watching their spending. The DARE Dance was very well attended and enjoyed by all.

Councilwoman Bonamassa stated the Tech Report was submitted by Nick D'Amico and noted the calendar seems to be a well visited section of the town website.

The Engineer stated the Williams Road Project was ready to go out to bid. The DOT will have their kickoff meeting for the Safe Route to Schools Grant. The NJEIT inspection went well. The Wilson Avenue storm pipe work has begun, and the DOT application for Jackson will be submitted by June 12.

The Mayor reminded all about the June 14 flag destruction ceremony planned at the American Legion. She also stated the 8th grade promenade at the Community Center this year prior to the Dinner Dance.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilman Wilson to adopt Resolution 2009:92 to authorize the rebid of the slip lining project. All Council voted aye.
