

MINUTES
COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 17, 2010
7:00 p.m.

The Municipal Clerk took the roll call and showed that all were present except Councilwoman Bonamassa. The Engineer Mr. Bach was present.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Martz to open this portion of the meeting to the public. Councilman Wilson seconded. All Council voting aye.

No one from the public spoke.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen to close the meeting to the public, seconded by Councilman Wilson, with all Council voting aye.
