

**MINUTES**  
**COUNCIL MEETING**  
**MAY 05, 2010**  
**7:00 p.m.**

In compliance with N.J.S.A. 10:4, Open Public Meetings Law, notice was given to two newspapers and posted, that a council meeting of the Mayor and Council was scheduled for Wednesday, May 05, 2010 at 7:00 P.M. The Municipal Clerk took the roll call and showed that all were present with the exception of Councilman DePrince. The Engineer Mr. Basehore was present.

Review of the agenda for the 8:00 pm session was completed.

Motion by Councilman Martz, seconded by Councilman Brandt to adopt Resolution 2010:83 for Closed Session, with all Council voting aye. Motion made by Councilman Wilson, seconded by Councilman Whalen to come out Closed Session with all Council voting aye.

The 8:00 pm session began, and Councilman DePrince was still not present.

The Police Chief made presentations of accommodations to Officer John Houston, Special Officers Daniel Columbaro, Eric Weist and Andrew Weist.

Motion was made by Councilman Brandt, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to open the meeting to the public. All Council voted aye.

No one from the public spoke.

Motion was made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman Wilson to close the meeting to the public. All Council voted aye.

Motion made by Councilman Brandt, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to adopt the April 15, 2010 meeting minutes. All Council voted aye.

Motion made by Councilman Brandt, seconded by Councilman Whalen to open the public hearing for the Resolution 2010:84 to allow the 2010 budget to be read by title only. All Council voted aye. Motion made by Councilman Brandt, seconded by Councilman Whalen to open the public hearing for the 2010 budget with all Council voting aye. No one from the public spoke. Motion made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman Brandt to close the public hearing and all Council voted aye.

**New Business:**

Business license for ReLaines Treasure Chest located at 803 W. Evehsam Avenue, B. 8.01, L. 5 was presented. The owner was present. She stated it was not a consignment shop and there would be no food. Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilwoman Martz with all Council voting aye by roll call vote.

Business License for Salon n' Vision located 308A W. Evesham Avenue, B. 1.03, L. 11 was presented. The owner was present and stated her manager had the required State License for the hair salon. Motion made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman Brandt to approve the license conditioned upon the repairs to be made per the Certificate of Occupancy inspection. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Wilson, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to approve Resolution 2010:85 for Maintenance Liens for 315 NE Atlantic Avenue, B. 2.05, L.16 in the amount of \$2,270.60; Madison Lane \$1,899., B. 7.01, L. 24; 509 Johnson Place \$150; 606 Harrison Avenue, \$150; 606 Grant Avenue, \$150; 701 Brooke Avenue, \$150.00; 203 S. Gloucester Avenue, \$150.00; 340 W. Evesham Avenue, \$150. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to adopt Resolution 2010:86 to allow the County Home Improvement Program application at 126 E. Adams. All Council voted by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Brand, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to adopt Resolution 2010:87 to award the reconstruction bid for the 100 block of Jackson Avenue to Paramount Enterprises, Inc. in the amount of \$117, 441.50. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilwoman Bonamassa, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to adopt Resolution 2010:88 to reject all bids for the reconstruction of East Madison Avenue and authorize the project to be rebid. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Wilson, seconded by Councilman Brandt to adopt Resolution 2010:89 to appoint Scott Cowling as a temporary seasonal laborer help for DPW at \$8.50 an hour. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman Brandt to adopt Resolution 2010:90 to appoint Richard E. Johnson as the sub-code fire official effective May 01, 2010. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Councilman Whalen read the monthly Treasurer's Report.

Councilman Brandt stated he was working on the Summer Recreation Program and the 4<sup>th</sup> of July festivities.

Councilman Wilson stated he submitted his report in writing.

Councilwoman Martz stated her report was submitted in writing.

Councilman DePrince was not present.

Councilman Whalen stated we were waiting on the State to adopt their budget prior to passing the municipal 2010 budget.

Councilwoman Bonamassa reminded council to use the website for any publicity for upcoming public events.

The Engineer stated his report was submitted in writing.

Motion made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman Whalen to open the public portion of the meeting. All Council voted aye.

No one spoke.

Motion by Councilwoman Bonamassa, seconded by Councilman Whalen to close the public portion, with all Council voting aye.

Motion by Councilman Brandt, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to approve the bill list as presented. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Brandt, seconded by Councilman Wilson to introduce Ordinance 2010:05 for the required stormwater regulations for dumpsters. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilwoman Martz, seconded by Councilman Brandt to introduce Ordinance 2010:06 for the required stormwater regulations for Retrofitting Storm Inlets. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Brandt, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to adjourn the meeting. All Council voted aye.
