

MINUTES
COUNCIL MEETING
NOVEMBER 03, 2010
7:00 p.m.

In compliance with N.J.S.A. 10:4, Open Public Meetings Law, notice was given to two newspapers and posted, that a council meeting of the Mayor and Council was scheduled for Wednesday, November 03, 2010 at 7:00 P.M. The Municipal Clerk took the roll call and showed that all were present. The Engineer Mr. Basehore was present.

Motion made by Councilman Brandt to open the public session for the 7pm meeting, and Councilwoman Martz made a second, with all Council voting aye.

Mr. Rich Michielli was present to inform the governing body of the liability carrier change to save money. He also stated there was no dividend to be paid from the JIF this year, but there will be a HIF dividend this year.

Motion made by Councilwoman Bonamassa, second by Councilwoman Martz to close the public portion with all Council voting aye.

Review of the agenda for the 8:00 pm session was completed.

The Mayor stated the Rabies Clinic is this coming Saturday. Also that flu shots would be this Monday at the Rec Center, and November 13 would be the train show.

Motion was made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilman Brandt to approve Resolution 2010:180 to appoint as substitute Crossing Guard Sharon DeLecce by recommendation of the Police Chief. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilman Wilson to table Resolution 2010:181 until the next meeting on November 18, 2010.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilman Brandt to adopt Resolution 2010:182 to appoint SLEO Officer James J. Swan by recommendation of the Police Chief. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Brandt, seconded by Councilman DePrince to adopt Resolution 2010:183 to approve the Change Order #1 for Madison Avenue for an increase of \$10,499.60. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.

Councilman Whalen read the Treasurer's Report.

Councilman Brandt stated his report was submitted in writing.

Councilman Wilson stated his report was submitted in writing.

Councilwoman Martz stated her report was submitted in writing, and added the Magnolia Diner was sold and the new owners have made settlement, and Sanders Contractors have made settlement on the Garden State Boat on the White Horse Pike.

Mrs. Liberatore inquired about a home near her that is in foreclosure. The Clerk explained the long process and that if the home requires maintenance the DPW will complete work orders as needed.

Bernie Wilson introduced himself as one of the tow companies that submitted a proposal for the 2011 contract. He stated he tows for Gloucester Township and Clementon currently. He has been in business since 1992.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilman DePrince to close the public session, with all Council voting aye.

The Mayor also congratulated Councilman DePrince and Councilwoman Bonamassa for winning the election yesterday.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilwoman Martz to authorize the payment of the bills. All Council voted aye by roll call vote.
