

**MINUTES**  
**COUNCIL MEETING**  
**SEPTEMBER 17, 2009**  
**7:00 p.m.**

In compliance with N.J.S.A. 10:4, Open Public Meetings Law, notice was given to two newspapers and posted, that a council meeting of the Mayor and Council was scheduled for Thursday, September 17, 2009 at 7:00 P.M. The Municipal Clerk took the roll call and showed that all were present with the exception of the Mayor and Councilman Brandt who had notified of their absence. The Engineer Mark Basehore was present.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Bonamassa to open this portion of the meeting to the public. Councilman Whalen seconded. All Council voting aye.

No one from the public spoke.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen to close the meeting to the public, seconded by Councilman DePrince, with all Council voting aye.

Old Business:

Ordinance 2009:17 was tabled again by motion of Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to the October 07, 2009 meeting. All Council voted aye to table.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince to table Resolution 2009:124 to the October 07, 2009 meeting with Councilman Whalen making the second. All Council voted aye in agreement.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilman Whalen to open the public hearing for Ordinance 2009:16 to amend Chapter 69 Police, Section 121 for Police Officer Eligibility Requirements to include minimum age of 18 years old and residency of Magnolia. All Council voted aye. No one from the public spoke. Councilman DePrince motioned to close the public hearing with Councilwoman Bonamassa making a second, all Council voted aye. Motion made by Councilman DePrince to adopt the amendment to Chapter 69, seconded by Councilman Whalen, with all Council voting aye by roll call vote.

New Business:

Fireperson application of Gerald Meagner, 214 David Place was approved by motion of Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa will all Council voting aye.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to approve Resolution 2009:134 to waive permit fees for the Magnolia Ambulance Corps for their upgrading their heating and air conditioning. All Council voted aye.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilman Whalen to adopt Resolution 2009:135 for a Chapter 159 for \$5,688.57 from the Drunk Driving Enforcement Fund Grant. All Council voted aye.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilman Whalen to adopt Resolution 2009:136 to authorize the execution of the Camden County Interlocal for Snow removal in exchange for road salt. All Council voted aye.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to approve the minutes for the meeting of September 02, 2009. All Council voted aye.

Motion made by Councilman Whalen, seconded by Councilman Bonamassa to approve the bills submitted by the Treasurer Robin Sarlo. All Councilman voted aye by roll call vote.

Motion made by Councilman Wilson, seconded by Councilman DePrince to go into Executive Session, with all Council voting aye.

Motion by Councilman Wilson, seconded by Councilwoman Bonamassa to come out of Executive Session. All Council voted aye.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilman Bonamassa to adopt Resolution 2009:137 to authorize a new TD Bank account for the confidential informant buy money. All Council voted aye.

Motion made by Councilman DePrince, seconded by Councilman Bonamassa to adopt Resolution 2009:138 to appoint a new part time laborer Branden Hankel for \$10.00 per hour. All Council voted aye.

The Engineer stated the Williams Avenue Project has addition money left and will get 100 feet of additional curbing and some driveway aprons.
