On Saturday June 8, 2013 at 9:09am a suspect, approached a female motorist at 540 N. White Horse Pike in Magnolia as she exited her vehicle. The suspect who was armed with a knife in his hand demanded the female give him the keys her vehicle. As the female motorist stood there the suspect grabbed her car keys from her hand and fled the area in her vehicle.

The vehicle and suspect description was broadcasted and minutes later Haddon Heights Police located the vehicle traveling on East Atlantic Ave. in Barrington.

When the officer attempted to stop the vehicle it took off at a high rate of speed and pursued onto the White Horse Pike.

As the suspect attempted to flee he struck two vehicles at the White Horse Pike and Nicholson Ave. in Audubon and continued on until the vehicle became disabled at the White Horse Pike at Cedar Ave. in Oaklyn. The suspect exited the vehicle and fled on foot with Haddon Heights and Haddon Township officers chasing.

The suspect was chased to the area of Cedar Ave. and East Atlantic Ave. where the suspect entered an open vehicle that that was being packed for a trip to the shore but there were no keys in this vehicle.

At this point the pursuing Haddon Township and Haddon Heights officers caught the suspect and took him into custody after a brief struggle.

The suspect was turned over to Magnolia Police to be charged. In addition to the charges out of Magnolia the suspect also faces charges in Haddon Heights and Audubon.
